The company has a fleet of 1,800 subcontracted haulage trucks that transports materials from quarries to production sites and building materials to customer sites.

Training on how to optimise data use

SOLUTION

Masternaut worked with Tarmac to define three metrics to focus on to achieve its key objectives. Each could provide big savings through small improvements:



Cut turnaround time of vehicles at the depot to boost productivity



Cut speeding to support safer driving



Reduce idling to make our operations more sustainable

A live, online dashboard was created to provide easy-to-access data for all reporting and is used by everyone from drivers to logistics directors.

A streamlined standard operating procedure was devised with the dashboard as the core tool used in reporting. All Tarmac managers across 400 sites received training on the dashboard, new reporting procedure and how to turn data into action.

RESULTS

Within three months of implementing the dashboard, all metrics showed significant improvement:



8% average decrease in turnaround time across all areas ²



3.4% average decrease in idling across all areas ²



Increased focus on speed monitoring, improving safety on the road ¹
